GENERAL

Seeding-

1. Each member school must play a minimum of 4 contests on 4 separate dates to be eligible to participate in state play-off competition.
2. Each NCISAA conference with four or more participating schools in a specific classification will receive an automatic bid.
3. The remaining tournament teams will be selected at large by the seeding committee - who will also seed the tournament - on Sunday, October 14th, 2018 at 1:00 PM at Greensboro Day School.
4. In all playoff games, the higher seed will be the home team.
5. The All-State Selection Committee will meet prior to the Seeding Committee.

Sport Rules-

1. Unless otherwise specified, National High School Federation rules will be followed.
2. A top of the line leather ball will be used.
3. The match will be 3 out of 5 sets to twenty-five. The fifth and deciding set will be to fifteen.
4. Warm-up before any NCISAA match will be twenty minutes.
 - a. The format will be 5 minutes, 5 minutes, 5 minutes, and 5 minutes.

Officials-

1. Each playoff match should be staffed by 4 approved officials (R1, R2 and 2 Line Judges).
2. The State Office will work with the host to secure officials for the Championship matches.
3. Officials for all other playoff matches are set up by the host school.
4. These officials will be paid directly from gate receipts.

Medical Coverage-

A North Carolina State Licensed Athletic Trainer or First Responder is required for all NCISAA playoff contests.

Reporting Playoff Scores:

The winning team is responsible for posting results in MaxPreps immediately after the conclusion of the contest.
