Out-of-Season Activities-

- Out-of-season activities are allowed, but are subject to the following:
 - Dead Periods:
 - Only apply to sports not in season.
 - Out-of-Season activities are not allowed during the following periods:

Season	Period
Fall	Starts the first week of fall season through August 31st.
Winter	Starts 1 week prior to the first day of the winter sport season and extends 3 weeks after Nov. 1.
Spring	Starts 1 week prior to the third Monday of February and extends 3 weeks after the third Monday of February.
May	Starts on the spring seeding meeting date and extends through the final spring state championship.

Mercy Rule-

1. Once a score reaches a 42 or more point differential by halftime or any point thereafter, the game will resort to a running clock except after scores, charged timeouts, and injuries.

Football Seeding Committee -

1. The higher seeded team will be designated the home team throughout the postseason.
2. VIDEO EXCHANGE: All participating teams must make the previous 2 games accessible via HUDL.

The higher seed will host in each division.

Playoff Times -

Weekday contests will start at 7:00pm (1pm on Saturdays) unless an alternate time is agreed upon by competing schools.

Playoff Format-

- 11-Man football will consist of one open division with two championships.
- Schools with enrollment of 375 or more will compete for the Div. I Championship.
- Schools with enrollment of 374 or less will compete for the Div. II Championship.

Sport Rules-

- Once a team has been seeded in the playoffs, a film exchange must take place.
- The higher seed shall initiate the exchange which should take place on the weekend preceding the contest.
- It is the responsibility of both teams to select a convenient location between the schools to make the exchange; a minimum of the last two game films are to be exchanged.
- The Executive Director and Sport Director or their designates will resolve disputes to determine adequate seating or lighting for playoff events provided the Executive Director is notified a minimum of two weeks prior to the potential game date.
- The following will be determined and the responsibility assigned for each item.
 - Adequate seating
 - Police protection
 - Officials
 - Scoreboard, clock operator, and gate keepers
 - Field marking and preparation
 - Counting and distributing gate receipts to the NCISAA
 - Reimbursement for game officials
 - Responsibility for pre-game publicity
 - Number of passes for each team
 - Jersey colors
 - Alternate date in the event of bad weather
 - Selection of a person to make a financial report to NCISAA.
 - Game time and date

Tie-Breaker Rule-

- In the event of a tie game in the playoffs, the tie-breaker rule as approved by the National High School Federation will be used.

Mercy Rule-

1. Once a score reaches a 42 or more point differential by halftime or any point thereafter, the game will resort to a running clock except after scores, charged timeouts, and injuries.
2. The game may be terminated by mutual agreement.
3. The clock will start when the ball is touched after the kickoff.

Officials-

1. For playoff rounds, the host site is responsible for securing officials.
2. For state championships at the higher seed, host schools will work with the NCISAA State Office in securing officials.
3. When the championship is being played at a neutral site, host schools will work with the NCISAA State Office in securing officials.

Medical Coverage-

1. A North Carolina State Licensed Athletic Trainer or First Responder is required for all NCISAA playoff contests
 - a. The NCISAA does not require an ambulance. Administrators should contact the NCISAA State Office for approval before hiring an ambulance.

Reporting Playoff Scores-

The host school administrator is responsible for reporting scores to the NCISAA State Office and posting results in MaxPreps immediately after the conclusion of the contest.
