## In-Season Activities-

## Out of Season Activities-

- Out of season activities are allowed, but are subject to the following:
  - Dead Periods:
    - Only apply to sports not in season.
    - Out of Season activities are not allowed during the following periods:

| Season | Period  |
|--------|---|
| Fall   | Starts the first week of fall season through August 31st.   |
| Winter | Starts 1 week prior to the first day of the winter sport season and extends 3 weeks after Nov. 1.             |
| Spring | Starts 1 week prior to the second Monday of February and extends 3 weeks after the second Monday of February. |
| May    | Starts on the spring seeding meeting date and extends through the final spring state championship.            |

## Sport Rules-

- National Federation of High Schools Rules (NFHS)
  - The NCISAA is an affiliate member of the NFHS.
  - National Federation High School rules apply when NCISAA rules do not cover a particular application.
  - Visit www.nfhs.org to find sport specific rules and annual updates.
- It is important for athletic directors and coaches to annually review rules changes each season. Rule Books are also available for online purchase on the NFHS website.

## Mercy Rule-

- 1. Once a score reaches a 42 or more point differential by halftime or any point thereafter, the game will resort to a running clock except after scores, charged timeouts, and injuries.
- 2. The game may be terminated by mutual agreement.
- 3. The clock will start when the ball is touched after the kickoff.

#### Playoffs

- 1. Weekday contests will start at 7:00pm (1pm on Saturdays) unless an alternate time is agreed upon by competing schools.
- 2. 8 teams will qualify for state playoffs.

## Sport Rules-

- 1. Once a team has been seeded in the playoffs, a film exchange must take place.
- 2. The higher seed shall initiate the exchange which should take place on the weekend preceding the contest.
- 3. VIDEO EXCHANGE: All participating teams must make the previous 2 games accessible via an electronic format.
- 4. The Executive Director, or designates, will resolve disputes to determine adequate seating or lighting for play-off events provided the Executive Director is notified a minimum of two weeks prior to the potential game date.
- 5. The following will be determined and the responsibility assigned for each item.
  - Adequate seating
  - Police protection
  - o Officials
  - Scoreboard, clock operator, and gatekeepers
  - Field marking and preparation
  - o Counting and distributing gate receipts to the NCISAA
  - Reimbursement for game officials
  - Responsibility for pre-game publicity
  - Number of passes for each team
  - Jersey colors
  - Alternate date in the event of bad weather
  - Selection of a person to make a financial report to NCISAA.
  - o Game time and date

#### Tie-Breaker Rule-

1. In the event of a tie game in the playoffs, the tie-breaker rule as approved by the National High School Federation will be used.

#### Mercy Rule-

- 1. Once a score reaches a 42 or more point differential by halftime or any point thereafter, the game will resort to a running clock except after scores, charged timeouts, and injuries.
- 2. The game may be terminated by mutual agreement.

3. The clock will start when the ball is touched after the kickoff.

#### Officials-

- 1. Each playoff contest should be staffed by five officials.
- 2. For playoff rounds, the host site is responsible for securing officials.
- 3. For state championships at the higher seed, host schools will work with the NCISAA State Office in securing officials.
- 4. When the championship is being played at a neutral site, host schools will work with the NCISAA State Office in securing officials.

## Medical Coverage-

- 1. A North Carolina State Licensed Athletic Trainer or First Responder is required for all NCISAA playoff contests.
  - a. The NCISAA does not require an ambulance. Administrators should contact the NCISAA State Office for approval before hiring an ambulance.

## Reporting Playoff Scores-

The host school administrator is responsible for reporting scores to the NCISAA State Office and posting results in MaxPreps immediately after the conclusion of the contest.
