### TEAM ARRIVAL & PARKING

Use the main campus entrance on Providence Rd. (Note: Some GPS systems direct guests to Raintree Lane – do not follow those directions.) Once you’ve entered campus, you will be on Fox Drive. Follow Fox Drive past the first two turns, continue around the large parking lot and up the hill, where Fox Drive becomes the bus lane. Follow it to the left as it goes between the Horne Performing Arts Center and Fennebresque Hall (B on the campus map provided). If there are no other buses, you may pull around to the Beck Student Activities Center where the hawk statue is located (marked with a white X on the campus map), parking against the right curb so other vehicles may pass. *Please refrain from stopping on the brick pavers.* If other buses are already parked on the curb, please pull in behind them.

### TEAM AREAS & FOOD

The Beck Student Activities Center has four double door entrances to the main lobby. Teams should enter the lobby and go to the right, through the double doors to the “tunnel” hallway (not through the gym). Follow that hallway to the end, through the double doors and into the wrestling room across the hall. Wrestlers should keep their personal items in the bleachers in the wrestling room. Team tables will be assigned and set up in the tunnel hall and in the back hall between the wrestling room and the SAC Gym. No food or personal items other than what is needed for a match are to be taken into the gym. Access to a locker room with showers is available for competitors upon request.

### SKIN CHECKS & WEIGH-IN

All wrestlers competing in the state tournament will complete their skin checks by CLS athletic training staff in the wrestling room prior to weighing in. Wrestlers will receive a stamp on the RIGHT hand for Day 1 skin check clearance, and a stamp on the LEFT hand for Day 2 skin check clearance. If a previously existing skin condition is present, wrestlers MUST bring a signed NFHS skin lesion participation form to present at the time of skin checks. If a form is not present and signed by a licensed healthcare professional, the wrestler may be considered ineligible for health and safety reasons.

### COMPETITION FLOOR ACCESS

Access to the competition floor in the SAC Gym will be limited to NCISAA staff, CLS athletic administrators, coaches, athletic trainers, and athletes with an imminent match.

### HOSPITALITY

Food and beverages will be available for officials, coaches, and tournament administrators in the Strength Center, located in a separate building directly behind the Beck Student Activities Center (marked as O on the campus map that follows). There is a door from the wrestling room that exits directly out to the Strength Center. A monitor will display the status of matches in the hospitality room.

### SPORTS MEDICINE

A certified athletic trainer will be on site at all times. Each team should bring their own materials for taping and general treatment. Water and cups will be provided at various areas of the competition floor, but athletes are encouraged to bring their own refillable water bottles. Visiting team athletic trainers are welcome and should [click here](#) for details regarding the CLS Sports Medicine staff, nearest medical facilities, and the emergency action plans for both the Beck Student Activities Center and the CLS Wrestling Room.

### SPECTATOR PARKING

Spectators should use the main campus entrance on Providence Road and take the second left on to Stadium Drive. Parking is available on the left in lot P5, or on the right in lot P4. Handicap parking is available at the top of Stadium Drive in front of the Beck Student Activities Center. Overflow parking is available in lots P1 off of Fox Drive, or P6 off of Hawks View Drive.

### SPECTATOR ADMISSION

Spectator admission is \$10/adult through the NCISAA's [GoFan Ticketing](#) page or \$15.00 cash at the door. Spectators must access their seats from the upper level by using the stairs in the lobby or the elevator on the far right side of the lobby. Seating in the Beck Student Activities Center are theater-style seats with backs. Chairs or stadium seats are not necessary. Access to the competition floor in the SAC Gym will be limited to coaches, athletic trainers, and athletes with an imminent match.



### COACH / ADMIN PASSES

### VIDEOGRAPHY & PROGRAMS

### AWARDS

Championship awards will be presented after every three matches throughout the finals. Head coaches of the division winner will present the awards. Parents and spectators will be allowed on the floor during the awards presentation to take photos, but must return to the stands before the next match begins. Please follow the instructions of the event staff at that time.

### STREAMING, CONCESSIONS & MERCHANDISE

Matches will be available to watch on the Charlotte Latin Athletics [channel](#) on YouTube, beginning 10 minutes prior to the first scheduled round. Charlotte Latin's Booster Club will be operating concessions, located on the left side of the lobby as you enter the building. Chick-Fil-A sandwiches, pizza, and a variety of snacks and drinks are available for purchase using cash, card, or Apple Pay. State championship merchandise will be available to purchase on the opposite side of the lobby and is also available online [here](#).

### CAMPUS MAP

The campus map that follows illustrates team bus directions and the location of spectator parking in relation to the Beck Student Activities Center. Note that GPS systems often direct guests to Raintree Lane – team buses should NOT use that entrance. There are no drivable connections from the campus entrance on Raintree Lane to the bus parking areas designated for this event. Use the main campus entrance at 9502 Providence Rd.
